

Scripture Reference: Luke 23:18-25 (ESV)

Luke 23:18. But they all cried out together, "Away with this man, and release to us Barabbas"—

Luke 23:19. a man who had been thrown into prison for an insurrection started in the city and for murder.

Luke 23:20. Pilate addressed them once more, desiring to release Jesus,

Luke 23:21. but they kept shouting, "Crucify, crucify him!"

Luke 23:22. A third time he said to them, "Why, what evil has he done? I have found in him no guilt deserving death. I will therefore punish and release him."

Luke 23:23. But they were urgent, demanding with loud cries that he should be crucified. And their voices prevailed.

Luke 23:24. So Pilate decided that their demand should be granted.

Luke 23:25. He released the man who had been thrown into prison for insurrection and murder, for whom they asked, but he delivered Jesus over to their will.

Synopsis – "Redeeming Barabbas"

As Luke's narrative of Jesus' trial before Pilate comes to an end, we will witness one of the most extraordinary events in Redemptive History: when the people Jesus came to save, willingly exchange His perfect righteousness and holiness for a violent, murderous criminal named Barabbas. We will make our way through the text noticing Pilate's clear acknowledgment of Jesus' innocence, as compared to the established guilt of Barabbas. And yet, when given the choice of who to release, the people loudly and decisively condemn Jesus and pardon Barabbas. Ultimately we will find in this travesty of justice, a glorious illustration of the Gospel, as the life of the One who was perfectly innocent is exchanged to redeem the life of the one who is guilty and deserving of condemnation.
